5) **Report of Service Providers:**



The presentation also addressed recent changes in pricing based on the official quote provided by Blanchat, which supersedes prior estimates.

Brad Beneski made a motion to proceed with the purchase of the 2016 Ford F-550 crew cab "Demo Truck" (B-6) in the amount of \$279,386.00, with an additional 10% tolerance. John Monton seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.


